


## II - A simple dynamical System

### 2.1 Motivation



Carrots  $N_C \equiv$  Number of squares filled by Carrots  
Rabbits  $N_R \equiv$  Number of " " " Rabbits

The quantity of interest:

$$x = \frac{N_R}{N_R + N_C}, \text{ fraction of squares that are rabbits.}$$

$$0 \leq x \leq 1$$

How  $x$  evolves from day  $t$  to day  $t+1$ ?

$$x_{t+1} = F(x_t) \quad (\text{discrete time dynamical system})$$

Conditions:  
 $x_0 = 0$

$$\begin{cases} F(0) = 0 \\ F(1) = 0 \\ F(x) = ax, a > 1, \text{ for } x \geq 0 \\ \text{Symmetry } x \rightarrow 1-x \\ F(x) = F(1-x) \end{cases}$$

Simplest case is  $F(x) = \alpha x(1-x)$

$$x_{t+1} = \alpha x_t (1 - x_t)$$

Given  $x_0$ ,  $x$  at  $t=0$ , we

Example  $\alpha = 2$

$$x_0 = 0.8111979\dots$$

$$x_1 = 2 \cdot x_0 (1 - x_0)$$

⋮

$$x_{10} =$$

Results:

$$x_{10} = 0.5$$
